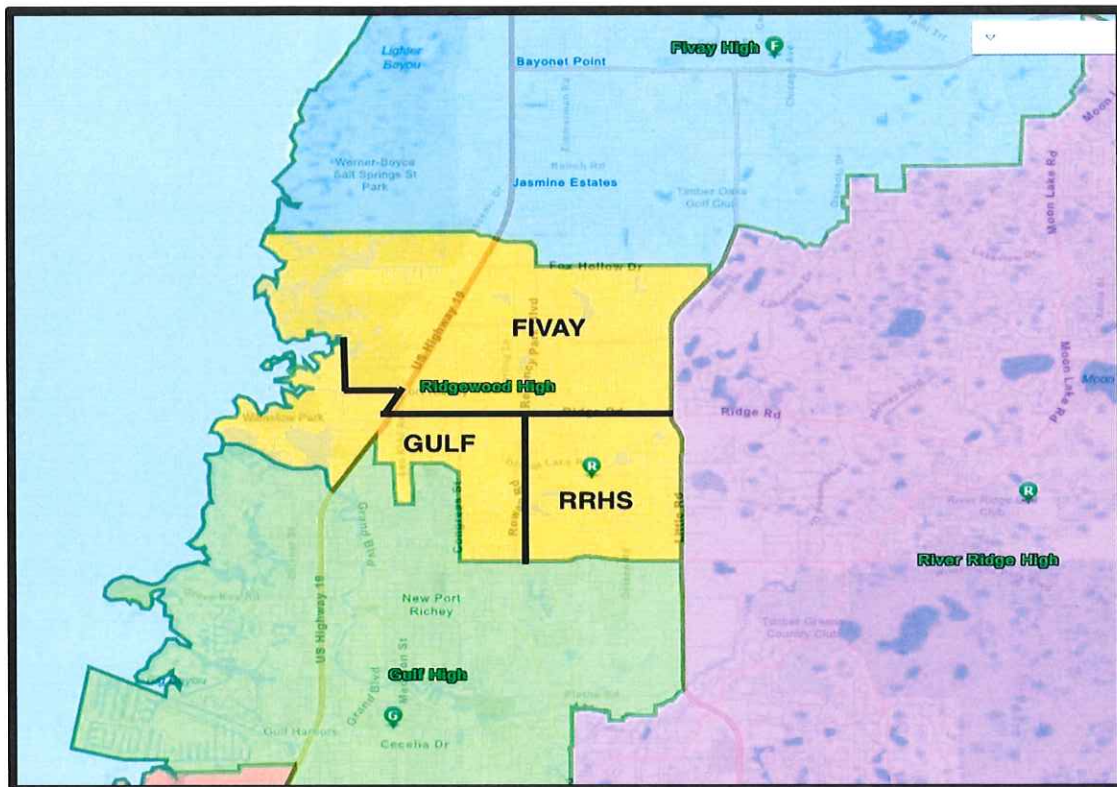
Athletics

REZONING

Some rezoning things to think about with regards for students that wish to participate in sports.

- *Per FHSAA policy, Students will need to participate in sports at their "zoned" school/or a school assigned by the district.*

Proposed Rezone:



The proposed split of Ridgewood students is undetermined, but let's suppose that they either attend Gulf or Fivay high schools. Those students would play athletics at their newly zoned schools. Students from high schools west of the Suncoast Parkway that choose to attend the technical high school will play in their zoned schools. Students east of the parkway would play at a district designated school. This will be necessary due to the inability to return students from the technical high school to afternoon athletic practice. It does, however, allow every student to pursue their athletic interests.

Athletic Equipment

Ridgewood athletic staff will need to inventory all athletic equipment, and determine if items are safe and suitable to transfer to another school. The District Athletic Office will then determine what schools will receive the equipment.

ITEMS THAT NEED TO BE INVENTORIED

- *Football Equipment (pads, helmets, practice cloth, sleds, chutes, blocking pads, balls, etc.)*
- *Wrestling (mats, time clocks, cleaning items)*
- *Basketball equipment (shooting machine, balls, etc.)*
- *Volleyball equipment (nets, standards, referee stands, balls, etc.)*
- *Soccer equipment (Goals, nets, flags, balls, etc.)*
- *Track & Field equipment (safety nets, hurdles, jump pits, etc.)*
- *Baseball & Softball Equipment (helmets, catchers gear, field items, etc.)*
- *Weight Room (plates, racks, machines, etc.)*
- *Training Room (tables, rehab items, unused supplies)*

Athletic Facilities

The District can still use the athletic facilities at Ridgewood for Use of Facility agreements and for the Middle School events, when needed. This would be a great opportunity for the District to make some money with existing facilities. The District may also choose to work with Pasco County government and/or various organizations, such as the Boys and Girls Clubs.

FACILITIES THAT CAN MAKE MONEY FOR THE DISTRICT

- *Tennis Courts (brand new surface in 2016)*
- *Gym (floor just redone in 2016)*
- *Football Stadium (Chasco Middle School plays games at this field)*
- *Softball & Baseball Fields*
