

2011 Great American Teach-In (GATI) Procedures

1. For individuals who will be presenting at GATI please direct them as follows:
 - a. Complete the District's online volunteer application, **if there is adequate lead time.**

 - b. If speakers approach you too close to the GATI date and there is not enough time for them to apply and be an approved "Volunteer," they need to be checked against the Sexual Offender/Predator database at the school and considered a "Visitor." Use the Raptor program to run this check -OR- log on to the site below to conduct and "Offender Search."

 - c. All speakers, even those who are "Approved Volunteers," are to be screened through Raptor when they arrive at the school.
 - d. The GATI coordinator must mark the speaker's application at the bottom to show the background check was conducted.
2. Volunteers and GATI participants do **NOT** need to be fingerprinted in order to present at GATI.
3. Have the Great American Teach-In presenters/volunteers sign-in on the GATI roster provided or one that you create. Provide presenters/volunteers with a nametag. A map of the school might be helpful even though **they must be escorted.**
4. Coordinate where and when the participants will present. Arrange to have the presenters **escorted** to the classroom or place they will be presenting.
5. Inform teachers that they must remain with their students.
6. At the conclusion of the Great American Teach-In, the coordinator will be asked to complete a short evaluation. The link to the survey will be emailed at a later date.
