Hearing		Sp/L Pathologist Private/ agency data is acceptable if documented in the health records		Students shall be screened at 20 dB at 1000, 2000, and 4000 Hz. Inability to hear at the specified intensity level for any frequency in either ear constitutes a screening failure. Any suspicious failure may be referred to the audiologist. Students who fail the initial screening will be rescreened (within two weeks). Failures will be reported individually on Speech, Language and Hearing Screening Report (Refer to MIS #789). Students with obvious medical problems should be referred to the school nurse immediately for subsequent referral to appropriate medical agencies. Following failure of the second screening the parent will be notified. If impedance and threshold testing is requested, parent permission to test will be obtained by the district audiologist Impedance screening will be conducted monthly by the district audiologist. Appropriate recommendations will be made for students who fail the impedance screening.
