JOB DESCRIPTION:

This employee is responsible for repairing and installing all types of air conditioning equipment with special skills to repair digital, pneumatic and manual control systems.

3. Provide advanced skills and knowledge in programming, adjusting, installing, maintaining, problem solving on various types and brands of HVAC control systems.
4. Provide advance knowledge and skills to repair water and air cooled chiller plants and variable frequency drive.
5. Assist AC Specialist on more difficult control problems.

2. EPA approved Universal Type Refrigeration Recovery Certificate as required by Federal Law, Section 608 of the Clean Air Act.
