Description:

Create visual space in your ASL interpretations. Using educational stimulus source material, participants will focus on spatial relationships; options for using real, token, and surrogate space; as well as for keeping space consistent. Participants will explore what to do when the spatial relations change or when the interpreter has forgotten the space originally established for a topic.

Learning Outcomes:

Participants will be able to:

- Assess their own work for systematic habits of utilizing referents in three-dimensional space
- Identify how they can apply ASL 3D spatial and referential strategies to content area classes
- Explore options for establishing spatial relationships while interpreting
- Develop skills for creating spatial referents in their work
