

## General Knowledge Requirement for Teacher Certification Statement of Understanding

Florida Statute Chapter 1012.56 (6.)(c.), regarding general knowledge requirements for certification, was revised during the 2000 legislative session. According to this new legislation, any individual who submits an application for a temporary certificate on or after July 1, 2000, must submit proof of successful completion of their general knowledge requirement within one calendar year from the date of first being hired in the state of Florida where their employment requires the individual to hold a Florida teaching certificate. However, if the anniversary date falls within the validity period of the employee's contract, then he/she will have until the end of their contract to submit proof of successful completion of their general knowledge requirement. If an individual does not show proof of this requirement by his/her deadline, then he/she will no longer be eligible for employment until such time that he/she presents proof of successful completion of the general knowledge examination. This includes employment as a long term substitute.
