Academic Improvement Plan

For a One-Year Waiver of Reading Intervention

Technical Assistance

Florida Statute permits schools to grant a one-year exemption from the reading remediation requirement. The school is NOT REQUIRED to waive reading remediation unless it believes the waiver to be in the student's best interest.

The waiver may only be granted if the student did not score below Achievement Level 3 on FCAT Reading in the previous three years. For example, a student who scored in Achievement Level 1 or 2 in 2011 may be granted the waiver if he or she scored in Level 3 or higher in 2008, 2009, and 2010. If, however, a student scored in Achievement Level 1 or 2 in 2011, scored in Achievement Level 3 or higher in 2010, scored in Achievement Level 3 or higher in 2009, but scored in Achievement Level 1 or 2 in 2008, that student would not qualify for the waiver.

According to the statute, a student is only eligible for a waiver if the FCAT Reading data is from the previous three consecutive years. Students that are missing FCAT Reading data from any of the previous three years do not qualify for the waiver. Most sixth grade students will not have FCAT Reading data from the previous three years.

Each individual school will be responsible for creating the Academic Improvement Plan for Oneyear Waiver of Reading Intervention. The school, student, and parent will identify specific actions each will take to improve the student's reading achievement and determine the monitoring schedule. In order for the Academic Improvement Plan for One-year Waiver of Reading Intervention to be executed, the parent or guardian must appear in person at the school to create the Plan.

Schools should maintain a copy of the Academic Improvement Plan but are not required to send a copy to the District. Schools should be able to produce the Academic Improvement Plan for One-year Waiver of Reading Intervention for any audit.
