Centennial Elementary School



Centennial Elementary School is being transformed into a STEAM dedicated magnet school in the 2022-2023 school year. This is an opportunity for parents to enroll their students in a magnet school where students will use science, technology, engineering, arts, and math to solve real-world problems.

What does this mean for students who have the opportunity to enroll in this new magnet school, and how can parents enroll their students? Here are some answers.



What is a STEAM dedicated magnet school?

A STEAM dedicated magnet school focuses on science, technology, engineering, arts, and mathematics to prepare students for college, career, and life. Rather than teaching these subjects in isolation, the magnet theme is integrated into the core curriculum. Through inquiry, critical thinking, and process-based learning instruction, students will develop real-world skills in the fields of robotics, aviation, drones, virtual reality, and more.

Why is a rezoning necessary?

Because STEAM dedicated magnet schools do not have traditional attendance zones and attract students from around the district, the school boundaries will have to be redrawn. Nearby attendance zones will be expanded to include the current Centennial Elementary School attendance zone.

Will parents have to apply to have their student remain at the school?

Students currently attending Centennial Elementary will be prioritized to remain through 5th grade. Parents who wish for their child to remain at Centennial Elementary can make their wishes known by completing the intent to return form available in myStudent. Information on how to complete this form will be shared at the parent information night on October 12, and the form will remain open until January 5.

When will the changes take place?

Full implementation will occur at the start of the 2022-2023 school year. The remainder of this school year will be devoted to preparing for the transition. It will involve identifying staff, providing the professional development needed to make the STEAM dedicated magnet school a success, and working through the rezoning process.

What about transportation?

For students remaining at Centennial Elementary School, your transportation will not change. For those students who choice into Centennial Elementary for the first time and who live outside of the non-transport zone, bus hubs may be available depending upon enrollment.
