INTRODUCTION

The 5-Year District Facilities Work Program is a very important document. The district's facilities work program must be a complete, balanced capital outlay plan that is financially feasible. The first year of the work program is the districts capital outlay budget. To determine if the work program is balanced and financially feasible, the "Net Ávailable Revenue" minus the "Funded Projects Costs" should sum to zero for "Remaining Funds".

If the "Remaining Funds" balance is zero, then the plan is both balanced and financially feasible.

If the "Remaining Funds" balance is negative, then the plan is neither balanced nor feasible.

If the "Remaining Funds" balance is greater than zero, the plan may be feasible, but it is not balanced.

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Planning

Class Size Reduction Planning

A new K-8 magnet school, Kirkland Ranch K-8, opened in the eastern part of the county this school year. This school is providing additional student stations for anticipated growth and is also drawing students from overcrowded elementary and middle schools in the area.

A new charter school, Dayspring Academy, Angeline Campus, opened this school year. This was a partnership between Dayspring and Pasco County Schools to help provide capacity for the new Angeline development. In addition, there are several new charter schools planning to open in the next five years. This will reduce the need for permanent student stations in this area as students from both under-crowded and overcrowded traditional schools migrate to these new charter schools.

A new K-8 school, Skybrooke K-8, is slated to open in the central part of the county next school year (25-26) to accommodate continued growth in that area. In addition to rezoning students to this school and relieving overcrowding at neighboring schools, this school will also allow for a significant amount of school choice, thereby reducing additional need for traditional permanent seats in that general area.

The school district continues to work on the sale of the Schwettman Education Center campus to the City of New Port Richey. Revenue will be applied to other projects and programs.

This school year the School Board voted to close Calusa Elementary School beginning in the 2025-2026 school year. The student body is being rezoned to the Chasco Elementary and Chasco Middle School campus and all three schools will be combined to form the new Chasco K-8. For the 25-26 school year, Calusa Elementary school will serve as swing space for Cypress Elementary School students while a campus renovation is done on the Cypress Elementary School campus. We are currently evaluating the long-term use of the Calusa Elementary school campus.
