

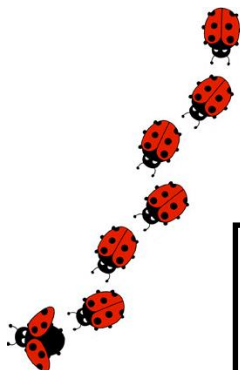

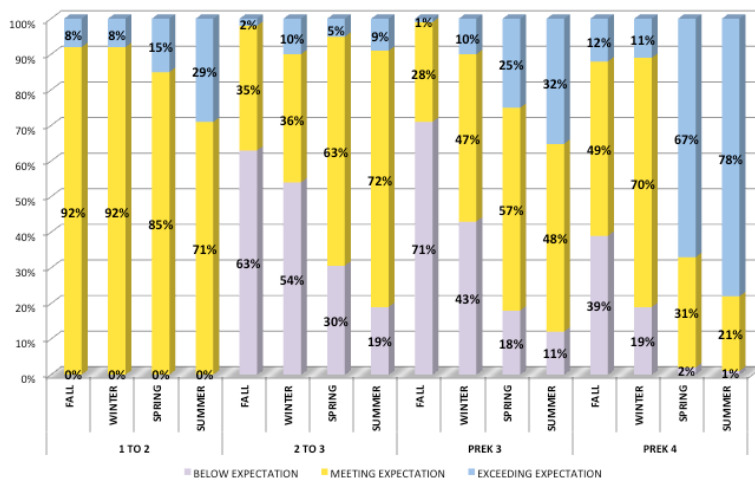
## School Readiness
