

1                                    **STUDENT FEES, FINES, AND CHARGES**

2        No provision exists which would authorize the requirement of payment of fees for  
3        consumable materials and supplies, educational materials, matriculation, or tuition  
4        as a prerequisite to a student's enrollment in public school.

5        The Board is authorized to receive gifts and donations and is held accountable for  
6        such. The Board is authorized to solicit students for financial assistance to cover  
7        the cost of consumable and other educational materials and supplies. The response  
8        to such solicitation must be entirely voluntary on the part of the student or his/her  
9        parents, therefore no sanctions will be imposed against a student who did not  
10       voluntarily respond to such solicitation.

11       The Board shall approve all fee schedules before they become effective.

12       **Lost or Damaged Textbooks**

13       An amount shall be assessed under F.S. 1006.28(3), when a textbook has been lost,  
14       damaged, or destroyed. Due notice shall be given the student to whom the textbook  
15       was assigned or his/her parent or guardian as to the amount to be paid for such  
16       textbook. Failure of the student or his/her parent or guardian to pay the amount  
17       assessed shall result in no further issuance of District owned textbooks to the  
18       student unless an exception has been granted. The principal may grant exceptions  
19       where extenuating conditions exists. Written evidence of the granting of such an  
20       exception shall be placed in the student's records. The failure to collect such sum  
21       upon reasonable effort by the school principal may result in the suspension of the  
22       student from participation in extra-curricular activities, other privileges, or  
23       satisfaction of the debt by the student through community service activities at the  
24       school site as determined by the school principal.

25       **Adult Education Fees**

26       The Board will set adult education fees in accordance with State statutes. Adult  
27       education students are required to pay the assessed fees unless exempted by State  
28       statutes.

29       **Adult Education Textbook Sales**

30       The adult education centers may charge adult students an overhead fee above the  
31       actual cost of the textbook, and the sales tax charged will be based upon this selling  
32       price.
