

NEW POLICY – VOL. 10, NO. 1

**NETWORK ACCESS FROM PERSONALLY-OWNED LAPTOP COMPUTERS
AND/OR OTHER WEB-ENABLED DEVICES**

District Board members, employees, students, as well as contractors, vendors and agents of the District may use their personal computer or web-enabled device of any type to access the District's servers and internet network while they are on-site at any District facility as appropriate.

The necessary standards for connecting to the District's servers and network shall be developed.

Establishment, and subsequent enforcement of the standards is intended to minimize the potential exposure of the District from damages, including, but not limited to, the loss of sensitive District data, illegal access to confidential data, damage to the District's intellectual property, damage to the District's public image, and damage to the District's critical internal systems, from unauthorized use.

Any Board member, employee, student, contractor, vendor or agent of the District whose actions violate the District's Acceptable Use policy, or who accesses the servers and network without authorization may be subject to disciplinary action, up to and including expulsion such as denial of access if a Board member; termination of employment if a District employee; expulsion if a student; or cancellation of the contract with the District if a contractor, vendor or agent. Further, the Board member, employee, student, contractor, vendor or agent of the District whose actions violate the District's Acceptable Use policy may be denied access to the District's servers and network in the future.
