

ESE Program Boundaries 2017-2018

This document is intended to identify schools with specialized programs for students with disabilities. In order to use the document, find the zoned school in the left column and track across the row to find the ESE program school with the designated ESE program.

Descriptions of ESE Programs are grouped below by the standards being pursued. All ESE programs serve students with a variety of ESE eligibility labels within each type of setting. The program names specify the types of ESE supports available in that ESE program.

ESE programs for Students pursuing Florida Standards

<u>Self-Contained Academic (SCA)</u> offers a program based on the Florida Standards for students with significant delays in academic skills and supports for mild/moderate behavioral needs.

<u>Social Behavior Communication Program (SBCP)</u> offers a program based on the Florida Standards for students with moderate/severe behavior, communication, and sensory needs that are associated with autism spectrum disorder.

<u>Social Behavior Program (SBP)</u> offers a program based on the Florida Standards for students with moderate/severe emotional and behavior needs.

ESE programs for Students pursuing Access Standards

<u>Access Curriculum Program: Independent (ACP-I)</u> offers curriculum based on the access points and supports for students with a significant cognitive disability at the independent level and supports for students with mild/moderate behavioral needs.

<u>Access Curriculum Program: Supported/Participatory (ACP-S/P)</u> offers a curriculum based on the access points for students with a significant cognitive disability at the supported and participatory level and supports for students with mild/moderate behavioral needs.

<u>Access Social Behavior Communication Program (ASBCP-I/S/P)</u> offers curriculum based on the access points for students with a significant cognitive disability at the independent, supported and participatory level and supports for severe/continuous behavioral needs, communication and sensory needs associated with autism spectrum disorder



supports. Students at the independent level may also receive supports at the Access Intensive Behavior Communication Program.

<u>Access Intensive Behavior Communication Program (AIBCP-I)</u> offers curriculum based on the access points for students with significant cognitive disabilities at the independent level, who require constant supports to address severe/continuous verbal and physical aggression. Contact Program Supervisor for support with placement and boundary clarification.

ESE programs for Students in Pre-Kindergarten

<u>Developmental Pre-Kindergarten (DPK)</u> offers a program for students with significant cognitive, communication, and independent functioning needs. DPK programs also provide skilled medical supports if needed.

<u>Social Behavioral Communication Pre-Kindergarten (SBC-PK)</u> offers a program for students with significant cognitive, reciprocal social interaction, communication, independent functioning, and/or sensory/behavioral needs.

<u>Pre-Kindergarten Communication (TALK)</u> offers a program to develop communication for students with moderate to severe expressive language delays and/or severe to profound speech delays.

<u>Pre-Kindergarten Varying Exceptionalities (PK VE)</u> offers a program to address the needs of students with moderate developmental delays in multiple areas via part-time or full-time basis.

<u>Therapeutic Pre-Kindergarten (TPK)</u> offers a program to address the behavioral challenges of students with severe social/emotional needs. Students with other developmental delays are considered on a case-by-case basis.

Other Supports

<u>Deaf/Hard of Hearing</u> itinerant services are provided at students' zoned schools. Students needing daily intensive auditory oral supports attend SOES and students needing daily intensive manual communication supports attend DOES.

<u>Skilled medical supports</u> are offered to students requiring such services (e.g. tube feeding, suctioning, etc.) either in the ESE classroom or in the general education setting.

<u>Visual Impairment</u> itinerant services are provided at students' zoned schools or in an ESE program school.
