

Work Evaluation is a systemic process to identify the vocational potential of school-aged youth and adults.

- Environmental Survey
- · Job Preparation Program Evaluation
- · Student Interview
- Digital Literacy
- · Skills Confidence
- Work Values

Work Evaluation

- Takes place in a simulated work environment where students identify educational and career goals.
- Is a service that assists with transition planning.
- Is customized to reflect individual needs.
- Motivates individuals to consider career options through self-awareness of abilities and preferences.

- Need information to develop attainable career goals.
- Are experiencing difficulties in their present education/career plan.
- Are eligible for services under IDEA (Individuals with Disabilities Education Act).

What is the outcome of Work Evaluation?

A comprehensive report is written containing assessment results and evaluation data.

A list of jobs that closely match the individual's guided assessment results is provided with the report. Information from the work evaluation can be used for the following:

- Transition planning.
- Planning for postsecondary training and direct employment.
- Developing goals for an employment plan.
- Identifying instructional strategies and accommodations.
- Determining career/technical and professional training options.
