

Memorandum of Understanding
\$1,000 Qualified Disaster Relief Payments
SRP Bargaining Unit
August 26, 2021

On June 2, 2021, Governor DeSantis signed SB2500, which among other things, appropriated funds to the Florida Department of Education to provide a nonrecurring Qualified Disaster Relief Payment in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) payable to full time classroom teachers, certified prekindergarten teachers and principals.

USEP and the District believe that all employees ~~should be included~~ in this benefit and accordingly desire to offer Qualified Disaster Relief Payments to all full time SRP employees who are excluded from the bonus provided in SB 2500;

USEP and the District agree to Qualified Disaster Relief Payments on the ~~terms~~ and conditions set forth herein.

1. Full time SRP employees covered in the SRP bargaining unit, who were employed by the district on the last contract day of their SRP school year for 2020-2021 will be paid one thousand dollars (\$1,000).
2. This payment is ~~non-recurring~~ and ~~does not become~~ part of the employee's base salary.
3. This payment is a Qualified Disaster Relief Payment, and taxes will not be withheld.
4. SRP employees who may be eligible for Qualified Disaster Relief Payments from other sources will not receive this payment.
