MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Board Proposal Title I Supplements May 31, 2023

Title I provides additional resources for activities designed to raise student achievement in schools with economically disadvantaged students. In an effort to help schools meet the requirements of Title 1 compliance and parent and family engagement, the District and Union agree to the use of Title I funds for the following:

A supplement of \$2,500 will be paid at the end of the 2023-2024 2022 2023 school year to the Title I School-based Compliance Coordinator for accessing, maintaining, and communicating Title I compliance-related information.

A supplement of \$2,500 will be paid at the end of the 2023-2024 2022 2023 school year to the Title I School-based Parent and Family Engagement Coordinator for assisting administration with engaging the community in all components of Title I that pertain to parent and family engagement. *This supplement is only available to schools that do not employ a full-time Parent Involvement Assistant.

The District and Union agree to meet prior to opening negotiations for <u>2024-2025</u> 2023-2024 to determine whether to continue the above supplements in subsequent years or make changes to these supplements based upon feedback from stipend recipients and Title One District personnel.
