



## ESOL CATEGORIES AND COMPLIANCE DEADLINES

- ❖ If you are a teacher of Reading, Language Arts or English you are required to earn your ESOL Endorsement or ESOL K-12 Certification within six (6) years of your initial ELL student assignment.

After receiving your first ELL student assignment you will receive an **ESOL Plan of Study – Category 1 Compliance Requirements**, which will outline your timeline, specific course titles according to your category, and potential options to satisfy the ESOL course requirements.

- ❖ If you are a teacher of Science, Social Studies, Math or other content areas you are required to take a sixty (60) hour in-service in *ESOL Essentials* by September 15<sup>th</sup> of the year following your initial ELL student assignment.

After receiving your first ELL student assignment you will receive an **ESOL Plan of Study - Category 2 Compliance Requirements**, which will outline your timeline and potential options to satisfy the ESOL course requirement.

- ❖ If you are a teacher of Physical Education, Art, Music, World Language or other areas not specified above, you are required to take an eighteen (18) hour in-service in *ESOL Content Area Strategies* by September 15<sup>th</sup> of the year following your initial ELL student assignment.

After receiving your first ELL student assignment you will receive an **ESOL Plan of Study – Category 3 Compliance Requirements**, which outlines your timeline and potential options to satisfy the ESOL course requirement.
