Investigative Steps (Use back for additional comments if needed)	Date	Initials
1. Determine if the reported bullying/harassment incident impacts the campus or school safety.		
2. Conduct interviews separately regarding the facts of the case. If appropriate, have alleged victim,		
witness(es) and alleged perpetrator complete written statements in response to the complaint.		
3. Consider issues of ELL, race, gender, and/or disability for all parties involved, as they may apply.		
4. Determine if allegation is:   substantiated or unsubstantiated		
5. Make a recommendation of immediate steps necessary to stop the behavior of concern.		
6. Refer involved parties for appropriate interventions as needed (ex: school-based problem solving team, Student Support Services assistance, Employee Assistance Program)		
7. On the same day an investigation of the incident has been initiated: Parent notification		+
consistent with FERPA via telephone or first-class mail for all students known to be involved in		
the incident. Parent notification for the student who was bullied or harassed will include		
actions being taken to protect the child.
