

Resolution Revising School Board Member Residence Areas

WHEREAS, the District School Board of Pasco County is a five-member nonpartisan body that makes policy regarding public education in Pasco County; and

WHEREAS, each member of the School Board must reside in the district they represent, with each of the five districts designed to ensure that each district is, as nearly as practicable, equal in population; and

WHEREAS, the 2020 Census indicated significant increases and shifts in population in Pasco County; and

WHEREAS, no change in districts that would affect the residence qualifications of any incumbent member shall disqualify the incumbent member during the term for which he or she is elected; and

WHEREAS, the School Board may make any changes to the district boundaries that it deems necessary; and

WHEREAS, the redistricting process must take place during odd-numbered years; and

WHEREAS, the redistricting process has no impact whatsoever on school attendance zones; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the District School Board of Pasco County has appropriately revised the five district school board member residence areas in conformance with state law, and incorporated the map indicating these revised district as part of this resolution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the District School Board will record the new boundaries in the office of the clerk of the circuit court and publish the new boundaries in within 30 days of this adoption.
