

- Northwest Elementary School / Hudson Elementary
 - Construction Begins Summer 2020, re-opens August 2021
 - Rezoning and portable plan
- Hudson Middle School
 - Construction Begins Summer 2021, re-opens 2022
- Hudson High School
 - Construction Begins Summer 2021, completes August 2023
