

Introduction to iObservation for Teachers

Welcome to iObservation! iObservation is an interactive online system where teachers can selfassess and collaborate with peers and administrators to continuously grow in their instruction and help every student learn.

Teachers can access iObservation anytime to:

- Self-asses to identify strengths and growth needs
- Receive observation and growth feedback from administrators and peers
- · Understand the common language of instruction that defines effective teaching
- View classroom footage examples of effective implementation
- Engage in private conferences and group discussions with peers and administrators

There are 2 sets of instructions in Sections A and B. Follow them to successfully get started in iObservation as a **Learner**.

Section A. Getting into iObservation

Follow these instructions to access iObservation.

- 1. Open an internet browser.
- 2. Type <u>www.effectiveeducators.com</u> in the address bar.
- 3. (Do not enter email address) Click the First Time User? link (takes you to new screen)
- 4. Type your email address in the Email Address box.
- 5. Click Submit.
- 6. Go to your school email account to find an email from no-reply@EffectiveEducators.com containing your username and password. Note: Check your spam/junk email folder if you do not see the email.
- 7. Click the link in the email or copy and paste the link into an internet browser.
- 8. Verify that the first name, last name, and email address displayed are correct.
- 9. *Optional:* If the first name, last name or email address are incorrect type in the corresponding box to correct the information.
- 10. Type a password in the **Change Password** box.
- 11. Retype the password in the **Confirm Password** box.
- 12. Click Save.
